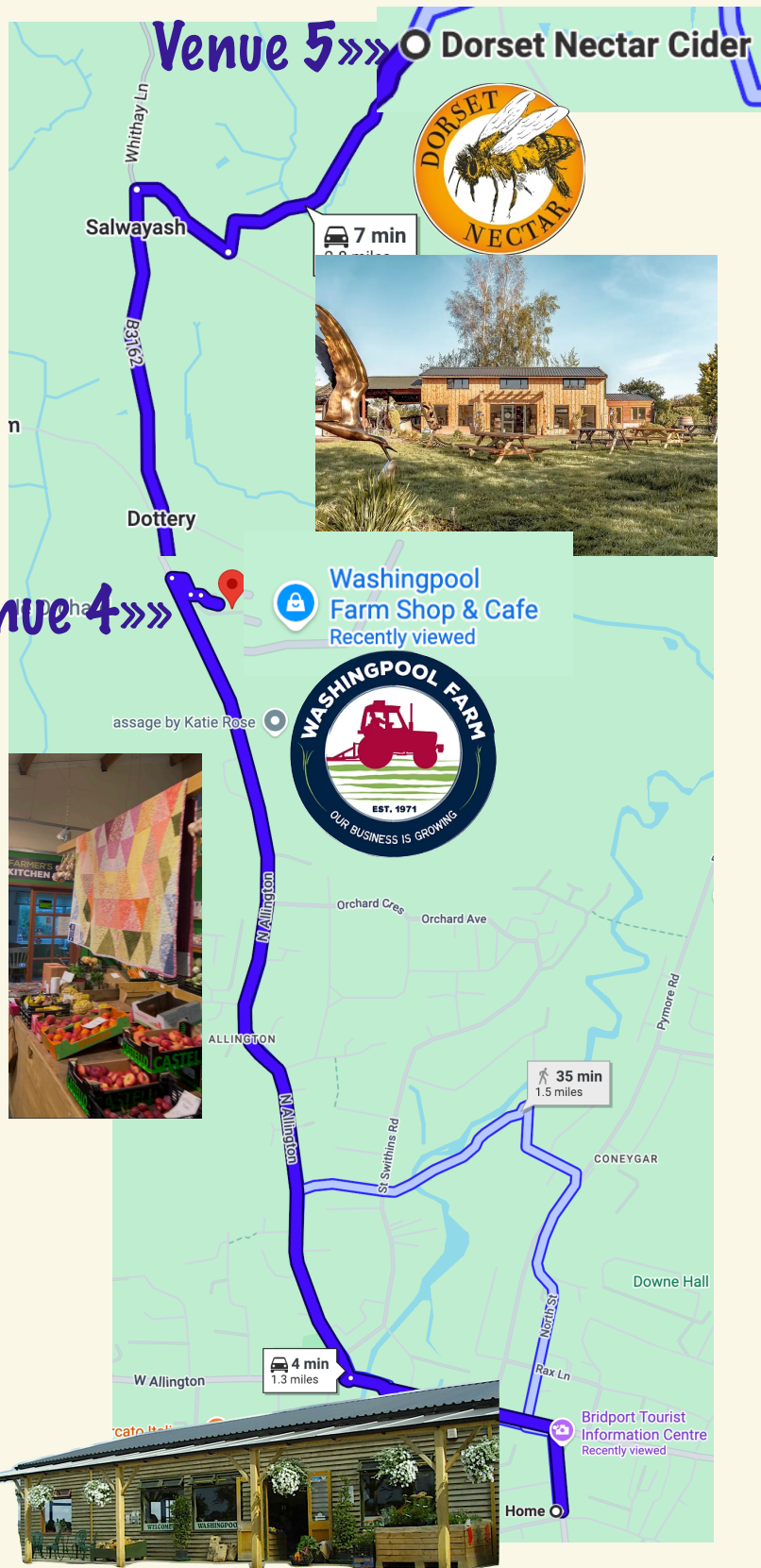

Venue 1 Oxenbury Yard

Open every day 10am - 5pm

Enter the middle door & be wowed by the big industrial space but warm welcome of Quilts! Individual quilts have names & information on them but I would say the show stoppers are The Lock down stitching by Kate Dowty. Kate stitched every day for 1 year! There is a prize if you guess the length! Put your answers in the tin on the bar!. You won't miss Matt Wildings Wings of Pride, they are the perfect photo opportunity. Matt finished this for The Men Who Quilt gallery at Festival of Quilts & I have patterns for sale in the shop! Another must see Quilt is my Monday group who dedicated a term to make one to raffle for Charity, See information next to the Quilt. And a last mention is new to sewing, & quilting, Maxim Cook. My favourite of his is 'Crazed Earth', a quilt depicting what's left after a forest fire.

Venue 2 St Mary's Church

Open Every day 10am - 4.30pm

This is the perfect venue to hang big Quilts! Not so many as we had in June last year, but still a spectacular show. Have a chat to The Quilt Angels who will be stewarding & taking care of them. You will see some manikins on display too! These have a selection of garments for the 'Walk Down The Aisle' which is happening the eve of Friday 11th. Get your tickets at TiC. Also some garments that will be modelled at our 'Passion for Sustainable Fashion Show on Saturday at 11am.

Show stopper quilts are Rose of Sharon Appliqué by Dawn. This was 30 years in the making, & everything I love about Quilting through time.

We have a medley of Kaffe Fasset Quilts that brighten a corner, a variation of Wedding ring quilt meticulously stitched by Christine Legg. But there is so much lovely things to list, you will just have to give yourself some time to look at it all!

Venue 3 The Library

Are you a member? Take the opportunity to have a wander round & look at the quilts.. as well as the huge textile installation show Bridport as a rope making town. There will be a spectacular array hanging from the balcony that wraps around the building & don't forget to look upstairs !

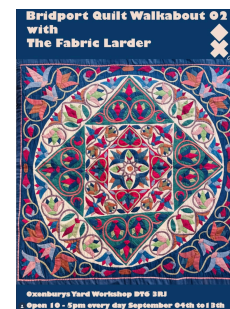
